1 BEACON OF TAÜLL

From Taüll (1,520 m), head south along the road towards Ribera de l'Ermita. A steep trail leads to the Beacon of Taüll, one of the best viewpoints in the Boi Valley. Perched above the town of Taüll, this dlimb offers sweeping views of the entire valley.

2 BEACON OF BOI

Starting in Boi (1,265 m) at the Square, head south along the road towards the Beacon of Boi. A steep trail leads to the Beacon of Boi, one of the best viewpoints in the Boi Valley. Perched above the town of Boi, this dlimb offers panoramic views of the valley.

3 BEACON OF ERILL LA VALL

From Erill la Vall (1,245 m), start at the Square and follow the road towards the Beacon of Erill la Vall. A steep trail leads to the Beacon of Erill la Vall, one of the best viewpoints in the Boi Valley. Perched above the town of Erill la Vall, this dlimb offers panoramic views of the valley.

4 BEACON OF BARRUERA

In Barruera (1,097 m), cross the bridge, turn right, and follow the road towards the Beacon of Barruera. A steep trail leads to the Beacon of Barruera, one of the best viewpoints in the Boi Valley. Perched above the town of Barruera, this dlimb offers panoramic views of the valley.

5 BEACON OF DURRO

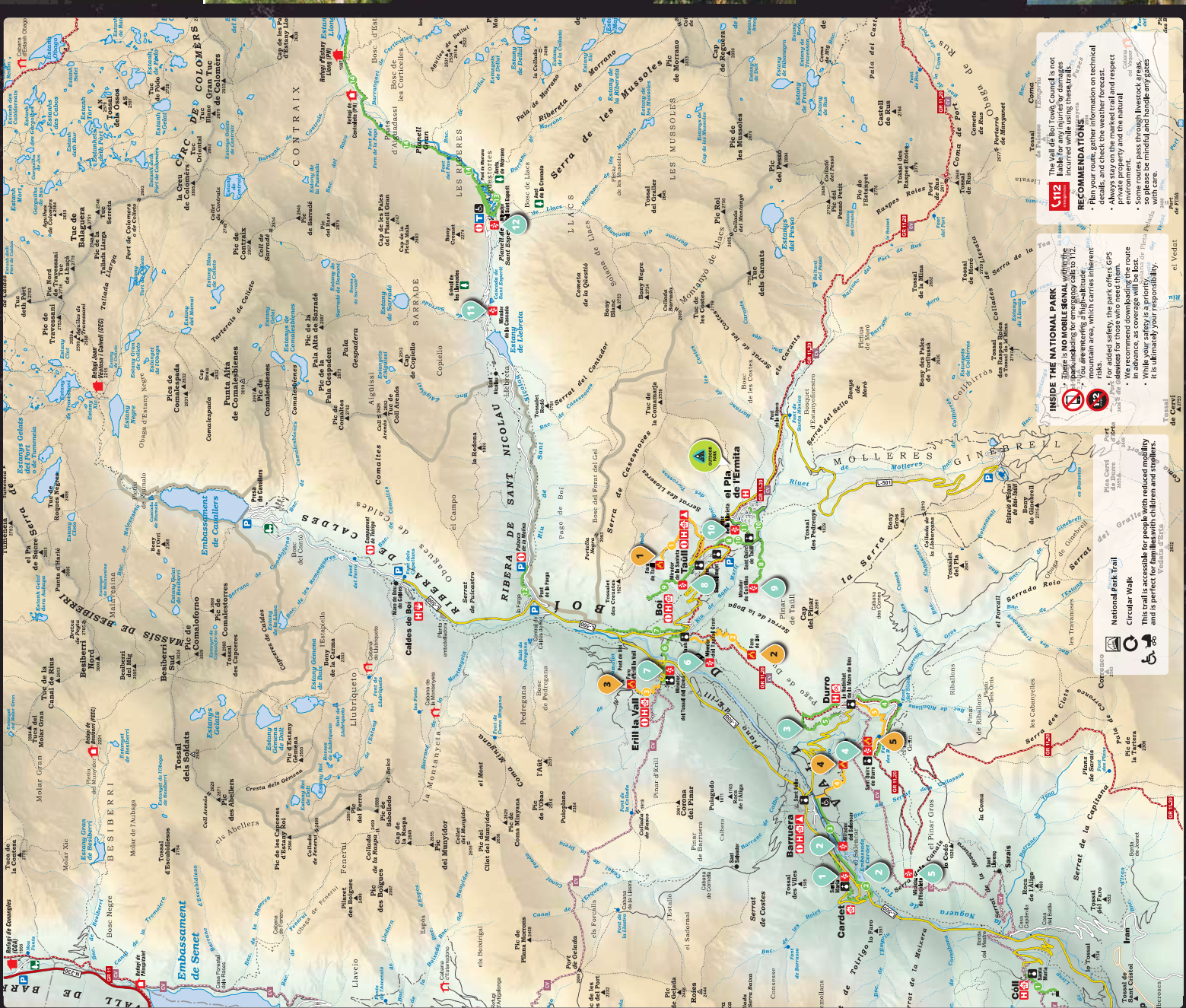
